# LOCKDOWN HEROES!

## 2020

1. **Eligibility:** Any youth, 18 years old or under.
2. **Age Grades:** You must choose an appropriate age grade from the following:
  - i. 5 – 9 years old
  - ii. 10 – 14 years old
  - iii. 15 – 18 years old
3. **Entries:**
  - a. To enter, send the following to [projects@uxbridge.org.nz](mailto:projects@uxbridge.org.nz) before the deadline: **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2020, midnight:**
    - i. Completed entry form, including artist statement.
    - ii. 1-3 high quality images of the completed artwork or a website link for video entries.
  - b. You may submit multiple entries. Each entry must be accompanied by a separate entry form.
  - c. You may collaborate with friends on a creation and submit it as one entry by multiple artists.
  - d. You cannot make changes to your entry, including the artwork and artist statement after the closing date.
4. **Accepted Artworks:** Your creations can take on almost any form! Painting, printmaking, photography, sculpture, film and other new media you can think of. However, live performance cannot be accepted.
5. **Originality:**
  - a. Your creations must have been made within the last 12 months and be influenced by the essential workers over the isolation period of Covid-19.
  - b. You must guarantee that the art you enter is a one-off original and hasn't been influenced by anyone outside of your Age Grade.

### **What the Judges are looking for:**

Artworks that displays your understanding and appreciation for the essential workers (healthcare workers, supermarket employees, dairy owners, postal delivery drivers, firemen and women, telecommunications workers ect) during the Covid-19 isolation and in general. Your creation should be original, eye-catching and thought-provoking.

- a. The judge is given full responsibility for selecting the winning artworks based on his or her judgement.

If your artwork is selected:

- a. You must make sure your creation is physically available to be displayed at 35 Uxbridge Road Howick, 2014, Auckland.
- b. You will receive an email after lockdown has finished, with instructions and dates to drop in your artwork for the exhibition.
