A basic kit of materials to get you up and going is listed below.

Specialist art shops are the best option and will provide student discounts from 10 – 20% if you mention that you are attending a workshop or class at UXBRIDGE Arts & Culture.

The stores we recommend are:

Studio Art Supplies – Crummer Road, Grey Lynn.

The French Art Shop – Taylors Road, Morningside.

Takapuna Art Supplies – Takapuna.

Chinese painting brushes - wolf hair and sheep hair; large, medium, and small size

Palette – I recommend using a white shallow dish or white tile instead of the normal watercolour palette.
